AGENDA TOPIC	DISCUSSION SUMMARY
<b>Welcome &amp; Minutes</b>	Grace welcomed everyone. The minutes from the fall 2017 meeting were approved with the addition of the following attendees: Adewale Togun (in person) and Joe Taylor (phone).
<b>APICS Ed Outreach</b>	Guest speaker Scott Luton shared information on “Supply Chain 101”, which is the curriculum APICS developed and is presenting to 4 <sup>th</sup> & 5 <sup>th</sup> graders in Georgia. To date over 400 children in several elementary schools in Cobb and Douglas Counties have participated in the program. The intent of the program is to exposed children to careers in logistics and supply chain management. More volunteers are needed to expand the program to other schools so interested instructors (and their students) are encouraged to contact Scott Luton at APICS.
<b>SCMA 1000</b>	Grace reported that she piloted the new curriculum using OERs and embedded CLA and CLT competencies. She had two students take the CLA assessment and pass. At this time students pay the MSSC testing fees. Grace recommended CLA and CLT completers be given credit for SCMA 1000.
<b>LOGI 1000</b>	Grace and Miles have been looking for OER materials. Anyone interested in this project should contact Grace.
<b>College Updates</b>	Atlanta – The instructor is new. He started last fall. His goal is to continuing reviewing the curriculum and place students. Albany – Gary’s interest is procurement curriculum. Athens – A search for a new Program Chair has begun. Central Georgia – Brad announced that Amazon is coming to his area with 500 new jobs. FedEx came to the area two months ago. Chattahoochee – Miles is managing continues to develop business contacts and update his curriculum. Georgia Northwestern – 33 students in the program. Three graduated last semester and 3 more will graduate in the spring in LAS3. The program is only two years old.
