## Ticket Information:

The Carpentry and Construction Management programs at Albany Technical College, Central Georgia Technical College and Ogeechee Technical College are utilizing the Carpentry curriculum which has been aligned with the National Center for Construction Education and Research (NCCER) Carpentry curriculum and have been accredited by NCCER. Wiregrass Georgia Technical College offers the CF21 TCC program at one of their local high schools. The opportunity to provide input for the course revisions by the Carpentry instructors at these colleges was given through email discussions. The proposed revisions were sent back to the faculty for input prior to being submitted for a Probe proposal.

When NCCER publishes new editions of their textbooks, previous editions may continue to be used for 5 years beyond the publication date of the new textbook. Beyond that 5 year time period, credentials can no longer be entered for work completed using the previous edition. To maintain program accreditation and continue awarding NCCER credentials to students, training programs are required to update their curriculum and adopt the new textbook versions prior to their current versions' expiration date.

New editions of the Carpentry textbooks were published in 2013 and 2014. Because of this, the current versions of the Level 1 and Level 2 textbooks will expire in 2018 and the Level 4 textbook will expire in 2019. TCSG programs do not use the Level 3 textbook.

The proposed CARP course revisions align the TCSG curriculum with the new editions of the NCCER textbooks. Contact hours were adjusted for the Level 1 textbook courses to fit the high school schedule for Dual Enrollment students.

Below is a chart showing the proposed contact hour and credit hour changes in the CARP courses.

## Summary of Program Revisions PAS Group 0280 – Carpentry

*AB71 – NCCER Advanced Carpentry*  
(Old Version 201512, New Version 201714)  
Albany, Central GA, Ogeechee

Removed COFC 1080 as it would have already been completed in a previous TCC. Substituted CARP 1025, CARP 1035, CARP 1055, CARP 1056 with newer versions. Both CARP 1055 and CARP 1056 are now required courses. Total credit hours remain the same.

*CF21 – NCCER Carpentry Fundamentals*

(Old Version 201512, New Version 201714)

Albany, Central GA, Ogeechee, Wiregrass GA

Removed CARP 1025 as a required course. Substituted CARP 1000 and CARP 1015 with newer versions. Added the new CARP 1020 course. Total credit hours were reduced from 17 to 13.

*CT22 – NCCER Carpentry Technology*

(Old Version 201512, New Version 201714)

Albany, Central GA

Substituted CARP 1000, CARP 1015, CARP 1025, CARP 1035, CARP 1055, CARP 1056 with newer versions. Added the new CARP 1020 course. Both CARP 1055 and CARP 1056 are now required courses. Total credit hours increased from 38 to 42.

Substituted CARP 1000, CARP 1015, CARP 1025, CARP 1035, CARP 1055, CARP 1056 with newer versions. Added the new CARP 1020 course. Both CARP 1055 and CARP 1056 are now required courses. Total credit hours increased from 27 to 34.

Substituted CARP 1000, CARP 1015, CARP 1025, CARP 1035, CARP 1055, CARP 1056 with newer versions. Added the new CARP 1020 course. Both CARP 1055 and CARP 1056 are now required courses. Total credit hours remain the same.

Substituted CARP 1000, CARP 1015, CARP 1025, CARP 1035, CARP 1055, CARP 1056 with newer versions. Added the new CARP 1020 as an occupational core course. Total credit hours remain the same.

*CMT3 – NCCER Construction Management Technology*

(Old Version 201512, New Version 201714)

Central GA, Ogeechee

Substituted CARP 1000, CARP 1015, CARP 1025, CARP 1035, CARP 1055, CARP 1056 with newer versions. Added the new CARP 1020 as an occupational core course. Total credit hours remain the same.
