Ticket Information:

At the ENGL HUMN SPCH IFCC meeting on July 14, 2016, the group voted to change the COMM 1109 Human Communication course to COMM 1100 Human Communication. No change in content or title—just change in number. The reason for the change was Kennesaw changed its number from 1109 to 1100 and more USG colleges use COMM 1100 for this course. Prior to the meeting a survey was sent out, and the results indicated that only the following colleges were teaching COMM 1109: Chattahoochee and Gwinnett. South GA is planning to offer COMM 1109 in the future, and Bainbridge College has one program in which COMM 1109 is offered.

After talking with representatives from Chattahoochee (who initiated the change), Gwinnett, and Bainbridge, the change has been made to the following programs (4 of them are institutionally developed at Chattahoochee and the other is institutionally developed at Bainbridge. COMM 1109 is now COMM 1100, and COMM 1100 will be the general education course used instead of COMM 1109. This change will take effect immediately.
