Ticket Information:

Over the past two years, a series of statewide meetings were held to review COMP 1000’s curriculum. The review process drew to a close last fall with the following recommendations by the newly formed Digital Literacy IFCC.

The curriculum revisions include a revised course title (Introduction to Computer Literacy), the inclusion of a new learning outcome relating to security, and a reduction in contact hours from 75 to 65 which was achieved by moving some of the existing Lab 2 over to Lecture. The WLU total drops accordingly from 108.75 to 106.25.

On February 21, 2017 all programs that showed COMP 1000 201003 in their curriculum had the new 201712 version inserted. Programs that have more than one version in the curriculum database had the most recent two versions affected by this change. All program versions remain unchanged.
