**Ticket Information:**

The ENGL HUMN SPCH IFCC met on July 13, 2017. The courses were reviewed and the following changes were recommended and approved after discussion. These changes have been made in KMS.

ENGL 1101 201003 (no change in version) – Research Competency - #1 currently reads “Locate and use appropriate reference materials for written and oral reports.” It was approved to add /or and read “Locate and use appropriate reference materials written **and/or** oral reports.” Since this course is articulated with USG and with the Independent colleges, Dr. Moore reviewed USG and GICA (GA Independent Colleges Association) courses to be sure this was not in conflict with their course description and there was no discrepancy. In fact, this change brings TCSG’s ENGL 1101 more in line with USG/GICA colleges/universities. No change to course credit, no change to minutes, no change to competencies, no change to course version. This change has been made in KMS and is in effect immediately.

ENGL 2110 World Literature (version change from 201216 to 201714) – To be consistent with ENGL 2130 (American Literature) and USG and GICA colleges/universities, the oral communication competency will be removed. The 375 minutes currently in the oral communication competency will be distributed in each of the other competencies as follows: Reading – 1275 (was 1125); Research and Writing – 975 (was 750). Course credit will NOT change, but the course version will now be 201714. These changes have been made in KMS and are in effect immediately.

ENGL 2310 English Literature from Beginnings to 1700 (version change from 201003 to 201714) – To be consistent with ENGL 2130 (American Literature) and USG and GICA colleges/universities, the oral communication competency will be removed. The 225 minutes currently in the oral communication competency will be distributed in each of the other competencies as follows: Literature and Culture – 500 (from 450); Essential Themes and Ideas – 950 (from 900); Literature and History – 500 (from 450); and Research and Writing Skills – 300 (from 250). Course credit will NOT change, but the course version will now be 201714. These changes have been made in KMS and are in effect immediately.

THEA 1101 – Theater Appreciation – To be consistent with USG and GICA colleges/universities, the performance competency will be modified to NOT include the 2<sup>nd</sup> outcome under the Performance competency. “Analyze and conduct a group performance of a dramatic or comedic scene, including script analysis and peer review” will be removed. No change to course credit, no change to minutes, no change to competencies, no change to course version. This change has been made in KMS and is in effect immediately.
