#### Ticket Information:

MATH 1103 Quantitative Skills and Reasoning is a new course for TCSG. MATH 1103 is articulated with USG's MATH 1001 (also Quantitative Skills and Reasoning) and was approved for articulation November 2015. This course is to be used in lieu of MATH 1100 and 1101 for non-science, non-math, and non-engineering majors and will count in Area III at TCSG (Area A for appropriate majors at USG). Science, math, and engineering majors will need to take MATH 1111 or higher. MATH 1103 is in KMS, and colleges may begin offering MATH 1103 as early as Spring Semester 2016.
