TICKET INFORMATION:

The Executive Committee of Barbering embarked on a significant overhaul of the Barbering program starting from June 6, 2023. Over a series of monthly meetings, they redesigned the curriculum, updating course titles and competencies. These revisions underwent scrutiny by the IFCC on November 2nd and November 8th, 2023, receiving unanimous approval from all eleven participating colleges. The detailed course titles and competencies are documented in Appendix A.

On October 31, 2023, federal Rule changes regarding gainful employment and administrative capability were released which resulted in the expedition of this program review and subsequent changes. In December 2023, the committee undertook further revision to ensure compliance with these federal rules and the State Board of Cosmetology and Barbering. To insure compliance, a 50 credit hour, Technical Certificate of Credit (TCC) – Master Barber (BA31), will replace the 56 credit Barbering Diploma (BA12) program. See Appendix B for detail.

Due to changes in courses that exist in both the Master Barber Certificate program (BA31) and Barber II (BI31), additional revisions were necessary to meet State Board of Cosmetology requirements, specific to the Barber II program's curriculum and contact hours, which are less than those required for Master Barber. The Barbering IFCC met on Wednesday, April 17, 2024 and voted to approve the revised BI31 Barber II program and the Master Barber (BA31) program.

Updates to specific courses were implemented to meet the 50-credit hour requirement for the Master Barber TCC (BA31), with eight courses-- BARB 1060, BARB 1072, BARB 1074, BARB 1082, BARB 1084, BARB 1090, BARB 1100, and BARB 1110 aligned accordingly. Additionally, five courses-- BARB 1082, BARB 1084, BARB 1090, BARB 1100, and BARB 1110 were proposed for inclusion in the revised Barber II program (now 41 credits). Both programs now adhere to all standards for Pell compliance, dual enrollment, and the State Board of Cosmetology and Barbering.

Consequently, a probe for both the Barbering (BA12-diploma to BA31-technical certificate) and Barber II (BI31-36 to 41 credit hours) programs was undertaken to ensure compliance. A one week probe was launched from April 17, 2024, closing on Wednesday, April 24, 2024.

Appendices B and C provide comprehensive crosswalks illustrating the transition from the old Barbering diploma (BA12) to the new Master Barber technical certificate (BA31) and from the current Barber II (BI31) technical certificate to the proposed revised version, respectively. These revisions emphasize the Executive Committee's proactive efforts to ensure the Barbering program remains robust and prepares students effectively for their careers.
