TICKET INFORMATION:

The Computer Programming IFCC unanimously agreed to remove the business option courses listed above from the degree and diploma citing the courses were irrelevant to getting a job. Removing the business option from both programs will result in a decrease in three (3) credit hours. The Computer Programming degree and diploma were also affected by a course change made to Web Design courses by the Web Design IFCC. The CIST 1510 Web Development I course increased from three (3) to four (4) credit hours.
