TICKET INFORMATION:

The VA13: Vascular degree program belongs to GA Northwestern Technical College (GNTC). After a recent IFCC review & approval of modifications by the State Board to the standards DMS3: Diagnostic Medical Sonography program, the college has decided to mirror a few of those changes within the General Education & Non-Occupational Elective areas.

By aligning the pre-occupational requirements between DMS3 and VA13, it will be easier for students who wish to switch their program choice after completing the pre-occupational coursework. This will ensure that students have met the pre-occupational requirements, whether they choose DMS3 or VA13.

The following changes were made to the VA13 program,

- Revisions to Area III: Natural Science/Mathematics
 - MATH 1103: Quantitative Skills & Reasoning (3hrs) course was added as an “or” option to the MATH 1111: College Algebra.

- MATH 1127: Introduction to Statistics was removed from the area and added to a newly created area titled “Elective Selection (2-3hrs)”
 - The removal of MATH 1127 resulted in reduced credit hours from 10hrs to 7hrs for Area III.
- A new area titled “Elective Selection (2-3hrs)” was added.
 - Within this area, an “or” option was created for ALHS 1040: Introduction to Healthcare (3hrs), ALHS 1090: Medical Terminology (2hrs), and MATH 1127: Introduction to Statistics (3hrs) courses.
 - This revision has allowed 2hrs of the 3hrs removed from Area III to be redistributed within this new area.

Overall, the program credit hours were reduced from 73hrs to 72hrs. Due to the reduction of program credit hours, a new 2022 version of the program was created. The program will be reviewed for approval during the March 16th State Board meeting.
