TICKET INFORMATION:

The MA22: Medical Assisting Diploma and MA23: Medical Assisting Degree PROBE voting period ended on Wednesday, February 3rd, 2021. 22 colleges currently offer the MA22: Medical Assisting Diploma program and 8 colleges offer the MA23: Medical Assisting Degree program. Based on the MA22 PROBE results, all 22 colleges votes in favor of the PROBE. There were a few comments concerning the program length change and the clinical hour requirement voted in by the IFCC. TCSG recommendation is to update the program length within the curriculum database, for it was an error overlooked during the data entry process. The clinical hours' comments will need to be further reviewed by the TCSG administration.

The presidents will review & discuss the probe results and provide final votes during the next President Council scheduled for March 9th.
