 - To further streamline programs while allowing for continued college flexibility and regional workforce needs, colleges are being asked to:
 - First, review the standard program and then other institutionally developed programs in the Curriculum Data Base (CDB).
 - Secondly, evaluate your program to determine if modification can be made to either the standard, or another institutionally developed program that will accommodate your local needs (less than 25% change). OR statements can be added as a modification.
 - This will make for better understanding of state level finance people.
