The RT23: Radiologic Technology program PROBE voting period ended Tuesday, April 20th. 18 colleges currently offer the RT23 program. Based on the PROBE results, 18 colleges voted. All 18 colleges voted in favor of the PROBE. One college providing the following comment of concern,

ARRT recently approved new curriculum standards that will go into effect January 2022. We would like to suggest that the proposed standards in this probe be updated with the new standards approved by ARRT to ensure our program reflects the most updated curriculum.

Based on that comment, TCSG will ensure that a Fall 2021 Radiologic Technology IFCC will be conducted to review the updated ARRT standards that go into effect, January 2022. The presidents will review the PROBE results on Tuesday, April 27th for final comments and review.
