The Medical Assisting IFCC met on October 8<sup>th</sup> and November 16<sup>th</sup>, 2020, to update the MAST courses to align with the Medical Assisting Education Board (MAERB) standards. The revisions within the courses resulted in creating the 2021 versions of the MAST classes due to removing outdated vocabulary used within the competencies and learning outcomes.
