TICKET INFORMATION:

The Medical Assisting IFCC met on October 8th and November 16th, 2020, to update the MAST courses to align with the Medical Assisting Education Review Board (MAERB) standards. The revisions within the courses resulted in creating the 2021 versions of the MAST classes due to removing outdated vocabulary used within the competencies and learning outcomes.

This information ticket is to inform colleges that the 2016 version of the MAST 1100: Medical Insurance Management course has been replaced with the 2021 version within the following programs,

In detail, the MH71, MC61 & MJ71 are institutionally developed programs, with the MAST 1100 course listed as a required course for completion. Overall, the 2021 version of the MAST 1100 course did not impact the total credit or contact hrs of any of the programs listed, and the hrs remained as is.
