### TICKET INFORMATION:

The Radiologic Technology IFCC met on March 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2021, and revised the RADT courses to align with the latest version of the American Society of Radiologic Technologist (ASRT) curriculum standards. The revisions within the courses resulted in creating the 2021 versions of the RADT classes due to removing outdated vocabulary used within the competencies and learning outcomes. However, the credit and contact course of the RADT courses remained untouched.

The IS51: Imaging Science Services Assistant TCC and RT21: Radiologic Technician Assistant TCC are standard programs with RADT courses embedded as requirements for completion. A 2021 version of both programs have been created to replace the 2010 version of the RADT 1010: Introduction to Radiology course with the newly designed 2021 version. Overall, the revisions made did not impact the total credit or contact hours of the programs. The IS51: Imaging Science Services Assistant program remained at 34 credit hours. The RT21: Radiologic Technician Assistant program remained at 25 credit hours.

Due to both programs being standard programs and based on the nature of the changes, a PROBE is required for final approval. Votes should be submitted no later than May 26, 2021.
