### TICKET INFORMATION:

During the program review process of 2019 the diploma program courses in aircraft structural technology were updated and revised. As well one existing embedded TCC was updated and two new embedded TCCs were created. The 2020 versions of these programs were state board approved in December 2019 and expected to be implemented by colleges sometime in CY 2020. The pandemic however, caused a hold on implementation. In April 2021 the program structure policy (policy 5.1.6) was returned to verbiage prior to September 2019 requiring diploma programs to contain a minimum of 8 credits hours of general education core. In order for the revised AST2 diploma program to be in compliance with current state board policy, EMPL 1000 was added back to the diploma program standard and a probe was generated. The total program credits rose from 46 to 48. There were no other course changes in the program and the embedded TCCs remain unchanged. The probe voting period ended on May 31<sup>st</sup>. All three colleges that teach aircraft structural programs voted by the deadline. All three colleges voted in favor of the change and had no other comments. This program revision will next go before the

presidents for their approval when they meet in July and then it can be approved by the state board in early August.
