### TICKET INFORMATION:

During the May 2021 IFCC meeting, a suggestion was made to have an internship pathway option made for both Commercial Driving TCCs for the range and BTW courses (CTDL 1021, 1031, 1051, 1061). The proposal was to create two new courses with the same content, hours, and credits as the regular on campus courses but which would allow intern students to actually be trained in their driving skills by an employer off campus. The two new internship courses were created above and then inserted in both 2020 CTD program standards as options for the on campus courses. As well, the names of the two TCCs were changed slightly to reflect the actual curricular requirements of the new ELDT training standards. The titles exactly match ELDT verbiage and remove references to endorsements (i.e. passenger vehicles) which will be theory training and best served using economic development training as the format rather than credit. The total program credits and hours remain the same and the existing 1040 internship course has been removed from the program standards. Colleges may implement these new internship courses whenever the need arises.
