Presented PowerPoint detailing Albany Tech's Civil Engineering program.
2. **Articulation Project- Sandra King**

3. **Class Types and Residency Codes- Alice Zimmerman**
Reviewed document reflecting course type codes. Continued conversation from previous meeting regarding possible class type and codes; residency codes.
4. **Health Prerequisites Discussion- Kathryn Hornsby/Sandra King**
Shared concern from a college president that KMS does not list specific program or course pre-req., therefore opening the possibility of students to take courses that they are not eligible to take. DeAnnia Clements shared how Wiregrass uses major codes and course pre-req. to ensure that students do not take courses that they are ineligible to take.
5. **Emerging Technologies- Electric/Hybrid Cars- Steve Conway**
Asked for faculty who would work with Steve to grow an Electric vehicle/hybrid technology program. VPAAAs can send names as soon as possible.
6. **Human Trafficking Awareness in Cosmetology- Anthony Gallman**
At the request of Georgia's First Lady, Martie Kemp, cosmetology curriculum be amended to include instruction on human trafficking. The Georgia Board of Cosmetology is meeting to amend rules. Once amended, a video will be provided to each of our college programs to implement.
7. **FSA- Clock to Credit Hour Conversion- Derek Dabrowiak**
Reviewed changes to federal conversion rate. Previously, the calculation was 37.5 X number of credit hours. Feds changed to 30 X number of credit hours. Only applies to clock hour programs.
