TICKET INFORMATION:

The information ticket is intended to inform colleges of a minor change within the DENA 1400: Dental Practice Management course. The DENA 1400 course is offered within the DA12: Dental Assisting, DE61: Dual Enrollment Advanced Dental Assisting, and AD21: Advanced Dental Assistant programs. The pre-requisites listed for the course state the following,

Pre-Requisites: All-Required

- COMP 1000: Introduction to Computer Literacy
- DENA 1340: Dental Assisting I: General Chairside

However, the only program with the COMP 1000: Introduction to Computer Literacy course listed is the DA12 program. Additionally, the COMP 1000 course is listed as an “or” option to the MAST 1060: Medical Office Procedures course within the DA12 program. To allow programs the flexibility of the DENA 1400 pre-req course requirements, the following update was made,

Pre-Requisites: One-Required

- COMP 1000: Introduction to Computer Literacy
- DENA 1340: Dental Assisting I: General Chairside

Changing the “All-Required” statement to “One-Required” allows programs to select which of the two pre-req courses students must take to meet the minimum KMS requirement, or programs can go beyond the minimum requirement and require students to take both courses if they choose to. Overall, the update was made to the 201412 version of the course. The contact & credit hours remained as is. Additionally, the programs listed below have the DENA 1400 course embedded within, and they all remained at the same contact & credit hours as well.
