Math 1005 Applied Technical Mathematics

ENGL 1005 Applied Technical Communications

TICKET INFORMATION:

Spring 2020 recommendations for an applied technical communications course and applied technical mathematics course were proposed to their respective IFCCs. The desire was to create new courses that more closely aligned to the communication and mathematical skills needed for professionals entering the industrial trades. Each group worked to create and refine standards for each course. Drafts of courses were submitted to the IFCC for final review and approval. All 22 colleges responded. For the English course at least 20 of the colleges were in support of every aspect of the course including the course description, course competencies and learning objectives. For the math course at least 19 colleges were in support of every aspect of the course. Minor edits were made to the course to address the concerns of those colleges that were not initially in full support.

The courses that were created were MATH 1005 Applied Technical Mathematics and ENGL 1005 Applied Technical Communications. The finalized versions of each course were made available in KMS for review. On July 27, 2021 all appropriate programs that showed MATH 1012 and ENGL 1010 had an “or” option of MATH 1005 and ENGL 1005 inserted. All program credit hours remained unchanged.
