- I. Faculty Credential Checklist- Dr. Marjorie Kuezi-Nke, Alice Zimmerman, Norman Cherry Reviewed the Faculty Credential Checklist with group. Asked if any additional information should be added or edited. Purpose: to identify the documents needed to approve faculty credentials.
 - Term “affiliate” questioned – language will be changed to “host.”
 - Advisory Council and Steering Committee will not approve courses since these have been approved by State Board.
 - Banner field exists with race and gender information, but not DOB. DOB is needed.
 - Dr. Perren cautioned all to try to avoid collecting information that could result in perceived discrimination. If the purpose of the credentialing checklist is to approve or decline instructor, only include those factors.

- II. Nurse Aide- Kathryn Hornsby
