The voting period for BPC1 Basic Post Certification ended on 10/15/2021. Currently 3 colleges offer the program and these colleges plus one additional college voted to agree with the program revision.

One comment was received: "Faculty Comments: "I agree with splitting these areas into three new courses. This eliminates the need for incomplete grades and better reflects the skillsets a student obtains in the program. This provides more emphasis to Emergency Vehicle Operation and - Firearms Training which are still pass/fail courses based on the practical application."

Based on the vote, the program revisions will be reviewed by the Presidents Council on October 25, 2021.
