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#### **WELCOME AND CALL TO ORDER:**

Current Officers were introduced, responsibilities explained, and new Officers selected. Brent Beall was nominated and re-elected Chair. Alicia Anderson was re-elected as Vice-Chair/Recorder

#### **DISCUSSION SUMMARY:**

General discussion about Chem courses 1151/L, 1152/L, 1211/L and 1212/L, which lead to a discussion about which USG colleges accept which Chem courses. Vice-Chair/Recorder to compile listing including the more "local" college agreements that may not be on the TCSG list. Also talked about developing a new one semester course more specifically designed for health care that combines elements from the four classes/labs. A lot of the USG colleges are not accepting 1151/L and 1152L anymore, but 1211/L and 1212/L doesn't include the biochemistry portion included in the 1151/L.

Dr. Dames introduced True Co-requirements that have been put in place that should prevent students from registering for classes without registering for coreq.

General discussion of faculty workload, TCSG vs ACS.

Agreed to meet again the first or second week of November to review curriculum and online resources.
