TICKET INFORMATION:

During the fall 2021 IFCC meeting, faculty voted to reduce the number of elective credit hours in the two precision manufacturing diploma programs listed above from 6 to 3. New versions of both programs were made. The 202212 version of CT12 was reduced to 51 credit hours and the 202212 version of MTT2 was reduced to 45 credit hours. The probe voting period ended on Nov. 22nd. Sixteen colleges offer one or both of these diploma programs currently. All 16 colleges voted agree with no comments. The probe results were reviewed by the presidents in January 2022. The full presidents' council approved these program changes at this time. The revised program standards will go to the state board for final approval at the March 2022 meeting. After that colleges will have up to one year to implement these new program standards.
