The PT21: Phlebotomy Technician and PT71: Phlebotomy Technology Specialist PROBE voting period ended on Tuesday, March 1. Based on KMS reports, 16 colleges are listed on the approved program list for the PT21: Phlebotomy Technician program. Three (3) colleges are listed on the approved program list for the PT71: Phlebotomy Technology Specialist program.

Based on the PROBE results, 17 colleges voted in favor of the PT21 PROBE with no additional comments. Eleven (11) colleges voted in favor of the PT71 PROBE with no further comments. The presidents will review the PROBE during the April 2022 President's Council. The PROBE will undergo a final review & approval during the June 2022 State Board.
