The MATH 1103: Quantitative Skills and Reasoning (3hrs) was added to Area III as an “or” option. The additional “or” option allows the RT21 program’s core requirements to align with the core requirements of the RT23: Radiologic Technology degree program, for those students looking to continue towards the degree route.
