**TICKET INFORMATION:**

The CLT3: Clinical Laboratory Technology PROBE voting period ended on Wednesday, March 30<sup>th</sup>. Based on KMS reports, nine (9) colleges are listed on the approved program list for the CLT3: Clinical Laboratory Technology.

Based on the PROBE results, all nine (9) colleges voted in favor of the CLT3 PROBE. Of those nine (9) colleges, two (2) colleges provided additional comments requesting revisions of terminology overlooked by the CPS during the data-entry process. The CPS has acknowledged the oversight and will update the curriculum database as requested.

The presidents will review the PROBE during the April 2022 President's Council. The PROBE will undergo a final review & approval during the June 2022 State Board.
