This information ticket is intended to inform colleges offering the ERT1: Endoscope Reprocessing Technician TCC program of a recent change. The FYES 1000: First-year Experience is a required course that belongs to and is only offered at Gwinnett Technical College. However, the COLL 1500: College Success course is a standard course that is frequently offered at other colleges.

Both courses are designed to help students acquire skills to achieve academic and professional success as they complete their higher education journey, resulting in creating an “or” option. Colleges will have the ability to select which course their students will enroll within.

The modification was made to the 202112 versions of the ERT1 program and did not impact the overall program hours. The program remained at 17 credit hours.
