### TICKET INFORMATION:

The AF13: Associate of Science in Nursing Bridge Pathway is an institutionally developed program offered at Southeastern Technical College. Upon an extensive review of the program and course standards, the college has requested several revisions to ensure that the standards are no longer outdated and it aligns with Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN) curriculum requirements and terminology. The college decided upon the following revisions,

#### **AF13: Associate of Science in Nursing Bridge Pathway**

- Within the 201712 version of the program the following revisions were made,
  - Using EMSI reports, the outdated Salary Trends data was updated.

- Occupational Analysis was updated and revised to align with the current professional and ACEN terminology.
- Program Outcomes were revised and updated to align with the current professional and ACEN terminology.
- Within Area III: Natural Sciences/Mathematics of the General Education Core requirement, an “or” option between MATH 1101: Mathematical Modeling and MATH 1111: College Algebra was added.
- Within Area IV: Humanities/Fine Arts of the General Education Core requirement, an “or” option between ENGL 2130: American Literature and HUMN 1101: Introduction to Humanities was added.
- The 201412 version of RNSG 1018, RNSG 1030, RNSG 2000, RNSG 2005, RNSG 2020 and RNSG 2030 were replaced with the updated 202212 version.
- The overall program hours remained as is. The program remained at 60 credit hours.

**RNSG 1019: Transition to Professional Nursing**

- With the creation of a 202212 version the following revisions were made,
  - Course Description was updated.
  - Pre-requisites was updated as follows,
    - All required
      - The following disclaimer statement was added to provide clarity to the pre-req requirements.
        - Students can select between MATH 1101 and MATH 1111 to earn the Area III requirement. Additionally, students can select between ENGL 2130 and HUMN 1101 to earn the Area IV requirement.
      - Program Admission remained.
      - BIOL 2113: Anatomy & Physiology I was added.
      - BIOL 2113L: Anatomy & Physiology Lab I was added.
      - BIOL 2114: Anatomy & Physiology II was added.
      - BIOL 2114L: Anatomy & Physiology Lab II was added.
      - BIOL 2117: Introductory Microbiology was removed.
      - BIOL 2117L: Introductory Microbiology Lab was removed.
      - COLL 1040: College Foundations was added.
      - ENGL 1101: Composition and Rhetoric was added.
      - ENGL 2130: American Literature or HUMN 1101: Humanities was added.

- MATH 1101: Math Modeling or MATH 1111: College Algebra was added.
- PSYC 1101 Introductory Psychology was added.
- PSYC 2103: Human Development was removed.
- Co-requisites were updated as follows,
  - All required
    - RNSG 1018: Pharmacological Concepts and Drug Calculation was added.
- Course credit and contact hours remained as is.
- Competency and Learning Outcomes were revised to align with ACEN terminology and standards.

Overall, the program's credit and contact hours remained as is. The program remained at 60 credit hours.
