1. Introduction and Updates – Dr. Kathryn Hornsby
 - The next State Board meeting will be held 8/3-4 at Oconee Fall Line. Please let Steve Conway know if there is an urgent need that should be addressed before that date. Steve can take these items to the Commissioner for late June approval.
 - July 20-21 next President's Council. Please get agenda items to Kathryn no later than the first week of July so that items can be reviewed by Curriculum sub-group.
2. Health Capacity Survey- Dr. Kathryn Hornsby
 - Please get to Annalise as soon as possible. Responses will be compiled and sent to OPB on Friday. Focus is on CNA, LPN, and RN program capacity.
 - Question was asked if the GBON rules had been accepted. No, the Governor has still not signed.
3. eCampus Support Services Pilot – Dr. Deonna Carter
 - Received a grant to offer support services in a pilot. Math and other gen. ed. courses (TBD).
 - Will be hiring tutors who will schedule time with students.
4. eCampus Fall Course Alignment- Robert Keown -
Shared and discussed spread sheet with fall host and home request.
5. Curriculum Update- Sandra King/Steve Conway
 - Apartment Maintenance: Working toward a short TCC that will train apartment maintenance workers. Will be discussing possibilities with a few metro colleges for initial implementation.
 - Basic Utility Technician: We have been approached by AGL and other utility companies to offer a new shorter TCC which will contain courses that already exist – will just be repackaged to a new TCC.
 - Aviation: meeting to be held this Friday. Jon Byrd from GNTC is the system FAA liaison. We are in a 120 day period through which changes will need to be made for implementation being the middle of September.
 - Commercial Truck Driving: Is there any possibility to shorten Class A training by using automatic transmission rather than manual transmission. A meeting will be scheduled with the CTD executive committee to discuss how to shorten curriculum. Dr. Perren stressed that this would be another TCC option. The manual transmission TCC will continue.
 - Sandra introduced our new AA CPS for Business Technology, Dr. Barbara West. Dr. West shared her background and her willingness to help colleges in coming months.
 - Sandra also stated that the high school articulations are moving forward again. More updates will be forthcoming next month.

 - Dr. Perren offered condolences to Albany Tech on passing of Dr. Parker.
