I. Fall Peer Group Meeting – Kathryn Hornsby

II. Option B and Policy Change Update – Kathryn Hornsby

A. Discussed 3 pathways that were discussed with PC Academic sub-committee and will go forward to full PC:

1. Mechatronics
2. Industrial Systems
3. Industrial and Mechatronics

B. Mentioned Micro-credentials and change to TCC hours:

1. New, 4th award level discussion, 1-5 credit hours.
2. Change in credit hour to TCC with lower limit of 6 rather than 9

III. Health Capacity Survey – Kathryn Hornsby

Kathryn and Dr. Perren thanked group for completing survey. OPB has asked for this information.

IV. eCampus

A. Dr. Carter discussed the pilot - math and economics tutoring pilot. Can offer support services to 12 sections. If there aren't 12 math and economics sections, they will broaden the offer to other courses.

V. Aviation Probe – Steve Conway

A. Aviation Maintenance programs. New FAA standards were released, group met early June, all needed changes are made. PROBE approved by sub committee this morning. Will be presented to full PC next week, with State Board approval in early August. September 21 is the date when the new curriculum must begin.
