

## VPAA Peer Group Meeting via Webex

Kathryn called the meeting to order at 3 pm and then she provided a few key upcoming dates:

Nov. 1 – STEM course listing revisions due; please use new spreadsheet for this year

GA DOE Articulations – Kathryn shared PP slides of 4 new program articulations while various CPS reviewed criteria for each:

Drafting – 2 courses possible 1101 and 1125

Criminal Justice – 2 courses possible 1010 and 1040

Cybersecurity - 4 courses possible, 1001, 1122, 1401, and 1601

Marketing – 2 courses possible 1100 and 1190

At the end of the articulation overviews VPs were asked to submit support votes in chat. All 4 articulations were agreed to move forward to presidents for review.

Unite Us Presentation – Robert Keown introduced Emily Kaplan to discuss why Unit Us exists and how it can assist veterans. The platform tries to connect veterans with available services. The system also helps to fill gaps that may exist for certain veterans. The next 12 months will be the implementation phase for TCSG colleges. Then the partnership will continue on after that. Emily proceeded to give a demonstration of the product and Robert then did a summary

CTD Updates – Kathryn explained that there was a recent update to truck driving standards. The CT61 TCC has a new course inserted for offering students a driving course geared towards the automatic restriction CDL test. The new course (1035) is visible now in the CT61 standard and any college that wishes to offer this track in the standard TCC can begin to do so. The new course is 3 credits like the other advanced driving options but has a bit more lecture time and is 15 hours shorter. The information ticket regarding this program change will be posted on the TCSG AA webpage shortly.

ECampus Calendar – James Chiara stated that the FY 24 calendar is adding standard parts of term dates. James asked VPs if the regular dates would work? They VPs agreed that standard dates would be fine to use.
