### WELCOME AND CALL TO ORDER:

Starlyn Sampson welcomed all attendees to the meeting. The agenda topics were reviewed and Starlyn led the discussions.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

Steve and Starlyn stated that there was opportunity for new folks to step into leadership roles in this IFCC. Starlyn has served as the IFCC chair for over 14 years. He would like to step down at this point. After some discussion among the group Tim Morton stated that he might be interested in becoming the chairperson. Tim said he would like to call Starlyn and talk through the responsibilities before he committed to this role. Tim shared his contact information with the group and he and Starlyn agreed to talk before the end of November. Then Steve would also follow back up in mid-December to see if Tim was ready to be the chair and also discuss one or two other folks who could be executive committee members. Starlyn asked Steve if there were any other course or program updates but Steve stated there were none in this program area. Two programs had closed in the past two years and potentially Chattahoochee was in a teach out. Starlyn asked Steve to once again cover the state of the last set of course changes made back in late 2019. Steve stated that these changes were put on hold by the presidents in early 2020 and that the older course standards still visible in KMS are the ones to still use.
