- AI Chatbots Jason Tanner
    - The technology can produce well written essays instantly.
    - Encourages faculty to use and discuss with students – technology will pick up plagiarism.

➤ Respondus concerns as well because it records cheating.

➤ Dr. Perren suggests gathering a group of academic affairs to study. Dr. Hornsby will be organizing a group to research this topic.

  - The concern is that in order to begin a new program, will SACSCOC require a faculty be on board at time of request? Can we share resources?

  - Kristen Buoy – per SACSCOC, they must have a faculty name at the time of submission.
  - Dr. Perren suggests utilizing an MOU between colleges to utilize a qualified faculty member. Will still need to have a full time faculty to start. Will need to be creative to attract faculty.
