The ASN Program Operations Director and faculty assessed the curriculum for the program and requested the following changes to the sequence of courses to have RNSG 2021 Fundamentals and RNSG 2024 Pharmacology in the first Semester. Pharmacology is foundational to the students, and we found they were not properly prepared to administer medications when it was in the summer semester with Medical Surgical I. We would like to request a KMS State Standards change in sequence and co-requisites.
