The following revisions were made to the MAST 1010: Legal and Ethical Concerns in the Medical Office.

- Competency #1: Introduction to Medical Law for the Medical Assistant
 - Learning Outcome #14: Perform compliance reporting based on public health statutes. (X.P.5 4)
- Competency #3: Ethical Considerations
 - Learning Outcome #3: Demonstrate professional response(s) to ethical issues. (XI.P.2 1)
 - Learning Outcome #5: Complete an incident report related to an error in patient care. (X.P.6)
