TICKET INFORMATION:

A request was made to research offering the Nurse Aide Accelerated Program (NAA1) in a shorter amount of credit hours to resemble what is being offered on the non-credit side through Economic Development. A presentation was made both to the VPAAs and the Nurse Aide IFCC in April, in which a 3-credit hour, 90 contact hour course was presented. This would be a new shorter program that would have one course that still meets all regular requirements as mandated by the Department of Community Health which regulates all Nurse Aide Trade Programs (NATP) in the state. The total NATP required hours are 85 total program hours. This new fast track course would have 90 hours (3 credit hours) and be delivered in a 4-week format. The System Office is aware of State Board Procedure **5.1.6.P Structure of Associate Degree, Diploma, and Technical Certificate of Credit Programs** that would have to be revised in the process of approving this three credit hour program. This curriculum change is pending this proposed revision for offering shorter certificates that will be discussed at the July Presidents' Council.
