The Nurse Aid Fast Track ( NAF5) PROBE ended on Monday, June 12, 2023. Based on the PROBE results all twenty (22) colleges all support the short new program. There were a few comments regarding the tuition model/fees for short programs, faculty issues, and a need to ensure that the hours presented meet the Georgia NATP requirements. TCSG is working with HOPE Career to look at ways to assist with tuition for short programs. Ms. Kahiga, Curriculum Specialist, will contact Alliant to ensure that the hours presented in the probe meet all Georgia and Federal NATP requirements. The proposed Nurse Aide Fast Track program is and will continue to be an optional program available within the Curriculum Database for colleges that can meet the needs of its service unit without negatively impacting or creating a decline in the needed funding or resources such as faculty, etc. to operate the program at its highest level of integrity possible.

The PROBE will be presented to the President’s Council during the July meeting.
