


Healthcare initiatives in Secondary Education

Georgia College & Career Academies

- 54 Active CCAs serving approximately 50,000 students
- A specialized school representing a partnership between secondary, postsecondary, and business/industry
- Course offerings are designed to meet the needs of workforce development in the community
- Healthcare programs are offered at 34 CCAs enrolling approximately 5,000 students
- GA CCAs offer both High School and Dual Enrollment Healthcare Programs in over 15 concentrations









Dual Enrollment

- Provides high school students with the opportunity to take college courses for both college and high school credit.
- A wide variety of healthcare courses and certifications are available to students including EMR, EMT, PCT,
 MA, and Phlebotomy
- Courses are taught on Technical College campuses, College and Career Academies, and High Schools.

Accelerated Career

- Dual enrollment program that provides students with another path to a high school diploma
- Students take a reduced academic courseload to focus on completing two Technical certificates of Credit at the college level
- Current approved Healthcare Programs under Accelerated Career include certificates in EMR/EMT,
 EMT/AEMT, *Nurse Aid/Geriatric or Residential Care, and Nurse Aid/*Phlebotomy

*Accelerated certificates available for Nurse Aid and Phlebotomy Tech



GEER II He a lthc a re Initia tive

- Over \$800,000 in GEER II Funding provided by the Governor Kemp's office to cover training costs for Dually Enrolled students
- Covered Nurse Aid and Geriatric Aid Certification for approximately 400 Students in SY23
- Will cover an additional 500 students during Fall Semester 2023





- The Dual Achievement Program is an another path toward high school graduation that allows students to <u>earn a high school diploma</u> at a Technical College System of Georgia High School Academy
- Students will complete both high school (if needed) and college course work at a TCSG High School Academy
- Students will graduate high school with a high school diploma and college credentials
- Current approved Healthcare Programs for DAP include numerous certificates in the areas of Medical Assisting, Nursing/Nurse Aid, and Paramedicine
