GA Board of Massage Therapy (GBMT)

The GBMT only provides licensure for Massage Therapist (MT), which is provided within the THMT courses. The THMT courses are the only courses impacted by the Administrative Capability federal changes.

The THMT courses meet the 440 hours of in-class supervised instruction and 60 hours of supervised student clinical practice as required by the GBMT. This will provide the newly proposed NMT TCC approval from the GBMT as a Board-approved MT program, and graduates of the program will be eligible to sit for the MT licensure.

The additional NEUT courses allow the students to take the NMT certification exam issued by another 3rd party organization, achieving the NMT certification.
