# Theoretical Content

# GBON Rule 410-9-.06(5)(a)

Minimum Curriculum Content. <u>An approved program of instruction or its equivalent shall contain no less</u>
<u>than six hundred eighty-five (685) clock hours of theoretical nursing and general education content,</u>
<u>and no less than four hundred eighty-five (485) clock hours of planned clinical practice for each</u>
<u>student</u>. Said program shall include the following subjects:

    - (xviii) Obstetrical Nursing Care

# Clinical Content

- (b) Required Clinical Experience: All of the following clinical experience areas must be provided in the curriculum:
  - 1. Basic Emergency Care
  - 2. Professional and Customer Relations
  - 3. Physical Assessment Techniques for All Body Systems
  - 4. Skills and Principles of Nursing Practice
  - Medication Administration
  - Intravenous Therapy Techniques
  - 7. Health Maintenance and Prevention of Illness and Injury
  - 8. Documentation of Nursing Care
  - 9. Nursing Care of Aging Clients
  - 10. Nursing Care of the Terminally III
  - 11. Medical Surgical Nursing Care
  - 12. Obstetrical Nursing Care
  - 13. Pediatric Nursing Care
  - 14. Mental Health and Illness Nursing Care
  - 15. Community Health Nursing Care
  - 16. Nursing Leadership and Management.

#### Admissions

- Current students preparing for the Fall semester whom
  you want to be in a Teachout for PN12 must be accepted
  by the college by July 1, 2024. If not coded PN 12 by the
  July 1, 2024 deadline will have to be taught under the
  new PN 21.
- Current ALHS instructors can now be utilized in PN programs or Nurse Aide Programs if meeting the criteria for employment in those areas.
- Each college has to determine its selection criteria ( working with the Pell regulator to provide some samples)
- GBON Practical Nursing rules do not currently specify faculty-to-student ratios in the classroom
  - Clinical ratios must still be observed (1:10 as allowed by clinical sites)

# Proposed Program Changes

- Embedded certificate within a degree-level program, which is currently being developed
- Allows more students to stay full-time for financial aid
- Still puts more emphasis on weaker NCLEX testing areas
- More time actually in program while meeting GBON requirements
- Students can finish school six months to one year earlier than current diplomaimproves workforce development
- Curriculum must be updated beginning Fall 2024
  - If student is enrolled or accepted prior to July 1<sup>st</sup>, they can be grandfathered in under the current PN curriculum
  - Must teach out existing cohorts and submit plan to GBON
- ACEN letter notifying of the non-substantive changes that are occurring and why – since not over 20%.

# Pharmacology

- Combines lecture and clinical
- 85 contact hours
  - Hours increased to fulfill GBON math requirements
- Focused on drug calculations and medication classes
- Medications covered in Adult Health, Maternal, Pediatrics, and Mental Health courses.
- Hands-on skill checks

#### **Fundamentals**

- Combines lecture and clinical
- 156 contact hours
- 75 clinical hours
- Hands-on skill checks remain in Fundamentals, but are removed from new Adult Health courses, ie Wound Care
- Medical Terminology embedded through program

#### Adult Health

- Combines lecture and clinical
- Only Adult Health covered, so Med-Surg renamed
- Reproductive, Pediatric, and Mental Health content removed
- Medical Terminology embedded for all four courses
- Anatomy embedded in all four courses. (ATI/HESI)
- Aligned with NCLEX-PN Test Plan
- Adult Health I- 157.5 contact hours, 62.5 clinical hours
- Adult Health II- 157.5 lecture/lab, 62.5 clinical hours
- Adult Health III- 157.5 lecture/lab, 62.5 clinical hours
- Adult Health IV- 157.5 lecture/lab, 62.5 clinical hours

# Mental Health

- Mental health is the lowest performing subject on NCLEX according to NCSBN
- Combines lecture and clinical
- 105 lecture/lab and 25 clinical hours
- Psychology embedded in this course
- Medical Terminology embedded in course

# Maternal Nursing

- Combines lecture and clinical
- 90 contact hours and 50 Clinical hours
- Maternal/ newborn topic is one of the lowest performing areas on NCLEX according to NCSBN
- Reproductive content removed from Med-Surg Standards and placed into Maternal Nursing
- Medical Terminology embedded in course.
- Simulation can be used for Pediatric /Maternity -Practical nursing education programs may substitute clinical simulation for not more than 75% of the clinical clock hours required in the study of obstetrics and pediatrics only.

#### **Pediatrics**

- Combines lecture and clinical
- 75 contact hours and 25 clinical hours
- Pediatrics is one of the lowest performing areas on NCLEX according to NCSBN
- Pediatric content removed from Med-Surg Standards and placed into Pediatric Nursing course
- Medical Terminology embedded in course.
- Simulation can be used for Pediatric /Maternity -Practical nursing education programs may substitute clinical simulation for not more than 75% of the clinical clock hours required in the study of obstetrics and pediatrics only.

# Practical Nursing Capstone

- Combines lecture and clinical (previously Leadership)
- 126 contact hours and 60 Clinical hours
- English content already in course. (paper/project)
  - Recommend students writing a paper and/or completing a presentation to fulfill GBON English requirement
    - One suggestion- Have students present a Quality Improvement Project for one of their clinical sites

#### **Questions?**

- 1. These changes are being brought on by changes to Federal Aid that limit the Practical Nursing program to 685 didactic hours and 485 clinical hours
- 2. Changes take effect July 1, 2024
- 3. Made into a certificate program
  - Increases workforce development because students finish certificate sooner
- 4. GBON Practical Nursing rules do not currently specify faculty-to-student ratios in the classroom
