### TICKET INFORMATION:

During their January meetings, the Practical Nursing IFCC and the Neuromuscular IFCC groups introduced the Associate of Applied Science in Allied Health Professions (AAS-AHP). The impetus for

creating this AAS degree stemmed from new regulations announced on October 31, 2023, particularly concerning gainful employment Administrative Capacity. These regulations necessitated a thorough reassessment of the program, resulting in a reduction of hours to comply with the updated standards. Following a review of the programs and guidelines, the decision was made to establish an AAS degree in health, enabling students to seamlessly transition from their current Technical Certificate Courses (TCCs) to a transferable AAS. The deadline for implementing these changes is July 1, 2024, affecting students starting in Fall 2024.

The (AAS-AHP) Associate of Applied Science Degree provides students with the flexibility to customize their curriculum to meet their academic and career goals in the healthcare sector. This program requires the completion of a range of 61- 64 semester credit hours, including 15 hours of general education prerequisites and 49 hours dedicated to healthcare-related courses. These specialized areas of study encompass comprehensive healthcare programs, emphasizing both theoretical knowledge and practical skills essential for entering the healthcare workforce successfully. Upon graduation, students will possess a strong foundation and relevant skills necessary to excel in various healthcare roles. Through close collaboration with a faculty advisor, students can strategically choose courses from specific concentrations that align with their career aspirations in the healthcare field. **The voting window on this Probe is 1 week related to the State Board Deadline – please submit by February 21, 2024.**
