Welcome

Grace Beam, IFCC State Chair, welcomed everyone.

College Updates

Each college provided an update on their student enrollment and changes/additions to programs at their institutions.

Georgia Northwestern reported that they are in the process of changing their curriculum for LAS3 to SC33. The change has been delayed due to Financial Aid considerations. Ogeechee Tech reported that they are looking for a full-time instructor for their SCMA program. Savannah Tech has a new program director Jillian Walton who transferred two months ago from Ogeechee Tech. Albany Tech reported on challenges students face trying to transfer their SCMA Associate of Applied Sciences degree to Bachelor of Science at four-year institutions. There is no clear 2+2 pathway. Central Georgia reported strong enrollment and offering a TCC at the Macon State prison, two new TCC's have been added SCS1 and LM21. Atlanta Tech is implementing Mercury Gate TMS which makes students more marketable and works closely with their veterans' program.

OLD BUSINESS

SCMA 1000

Grace Beam reported that the OER currently in use in SCMA1000 which is based on MSSC's CLA/CLT competencies has been updated and may need to be revised. Standards and competencies may need to be revised. A subcommittee was formed to review the SCMA 1000 OER. Subcommittee member are Grace Beam, Jillian Walton, Kim Johns and Von Gatewood.

Freight Brokerage

Southern Crescent reported that a Freight Brokerage course and TCC were approved by the State Board. Kim Johns will share with the group a PowerPoint and information about the program.

E-campus update

Dr. West reported that there is a new TCSG Director overseeing e-campus. More occupational courses are going to be offered on e-campus providing students with opportunities to finish their programs in a timely manner.
