TICKET INFORMATION:

The Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Professions PROBE voting period ended on Thursday, September 12th. The PROBE results are as follows:

ED91: Emergency Medical Technician: EMT

- This program is intended to replace the EMJ1: Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) program.
- According to the Program Approved List via the KMS reports, 21 colleges offer the program.
- 12 colleges voted
- 6 colleges did not provide a vote
- 9 colleges voted "NO"
- 3 colleges voted "YES"
- Various comments about program hours, program offerings, accreditation timelines, the allotted time for teaching TCSG & State Office standards, the revisions of course offerings, etc., were a few of the comments provided for "NO" votes.

EMH1: Advanced Emergency Medical Technician: AEMT

- According to the Program Approved List via the KMS reports, 21 colleges offer the program.
- 16 colleges voted
- 5 colleges did not provide a vote
- 9 colleges voted "NO"
- 7 colleges voted "YES"
- Various comments about program hours, program offerings, accreditation timelines, the allotted time for teaching TCSG & State Office standards, the revisions of course offerings, etc., were a few of the comments provided for "NO" votes.

PT12: Paramedicine

- According to the Program Approved List via the KMS reports, 19 colleges offer the program.
- 15 colleges voted
- 4 colleges did not provide a vote
- 3 colleges voted "NO"
- 12 colleges voted "YES"

- Various comments about program hours, program offerings, accreditation timelines, the allotted time for teaching TCSG & State Office standards, the revisions of course offerings, etc., were a few of the comments provided for “NO” votes.

AFA3: Associate of Applied Science in Allied Health Professions

- This program is intended to replace the PT13: Paramedicine program.
- An official PROBE vote for the program was not taken; however, the same occupational core courses within PT12: Paramedicine are the same for the PT13: Paramedicine program, so the votes & comments for the PT12 program fall in line with the votes required for the AFA3 program.
- Ultimately, the comments of the “NO” votes of the occupational core courses remain the same and will be accounted for in this program.

EE91: Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Professions

- According to the Program Approved List via the KMS reports, 20 colleges offer the program.
- 14 colleges voted
- 4 colleges did not provide a vote
- 11 colleges voted “NO”
- 3 colleges voted “YES”
- Various comments about program hours, program offerings, accreditation timelines, the allotted time for teaching TCSG & State Office standards, the revisions of course offerings, and the need for the program to remain a diploma, etc., were a few of the comments provided for “NO” votes.

The PROBE results and the State Office of EMS data of TCSG EMS programs will be discussed during the September 2024 President Council (PC). Based on these discussions and reviews, further recommendations will be presented during the October 2024 PC.
